Did you know that only 1 out of 12 cats that are born ever find a permanent home? A single cat can produce at least 180 kittens over her lifetime. So many cats and unwanted animals are passed from one bad home to another, and that are abandoned. These animals are often plunged into a lifetime of disease and suffering. Even if they make it to a community shelter, they are likely to be euthanized because our shelters are not able to handle them.

Did you know that spaying and neutering cats and dogs benefits your community? Stray animals get into garbage cans, and can scare people and cause car accidents. Stray animals, out of desperation, can kill or injure wildlife. Communities are not equipped to manage these unwanted, abandoned and neglected animals.




Community Corner

There is 35 acres of land, bordering the Saco River and neighboring Bear Peak Ski Resort. Little Angels has started renovations to prepare for trainers and dogs working on site. One of the best parts is that trainers will be living on site and the dogs will be living with trainers. This allows them to avoid having to build a large kennel on site immediately and is a great way to alleviate the stress on the dogs by having them in a home environment. Two cottages and one chalet are being renovated for the trainers to move into as soon as possible.

These wonderful service dogs can assist their two legged friends in so many ways such as: assistance for persons with autism, hearing loss, mobility issues, psychiatric problems, seizure alerts, PTSD, and many more needs.

Ask the Vet...

The last Tuesday in February is World Spay Day!

Remember to get your cats and dogs spayed/ neutered which reduces the incidence of many health issues for them and also reduces the number of animals entering shelters and ultimately being euthanized. The recommended ages for spay/neuter surgery by many veterinarians are:

Cats: male and female, before 5 months Dogs: male - small breeds, before 5 months male - large breeds, 15 to 18 months
