more homeless animals.'

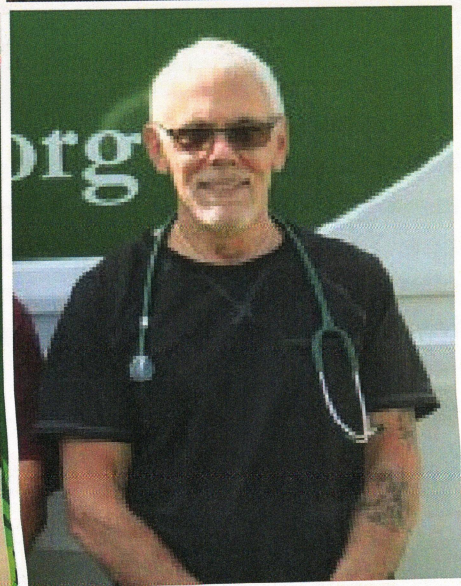
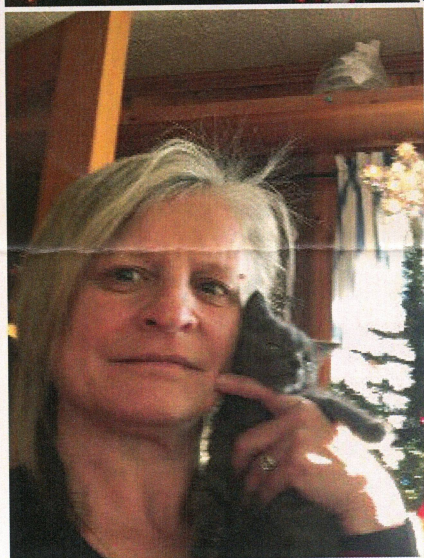

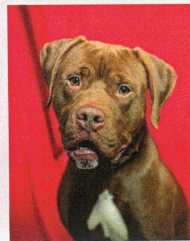

**Responsible Pet Care of Oxford Hills, South Paris, ME  
Saving Animals. Serving The Community.**

Responsible Pet Care Shelter & Adoption provides a compassionate, loving environment for homeless felines and canines while they await their new forever homes. They are a no-kill, no-suffer, 501c3 non-profit shelter and adoption center for felines and canines.

Prior to their formal incorporation in 1997, they operated as a grass roots effort by a small group of dedicated, compassionate people recognizing the plight and need of homeless pets, welcoming them into their homes, garages and basements.

The first shelter was purchased via a tax sale from the Town of Norway and was used primarily to be a feline shelter. When a dog shelter operated by the animal control officer could no longer meet the standards of licensing, they felt the obligation to take on that responsibility as well. A very generous, supportive community raised money to purchase an existing building in South Paris, ME.

The doors to the new shelter were opened in May 2014.
