Ask the Vet...

Get your 'girls' fixed early!

The guidelines for the appropriate age to have your cats and dogs 'fixed' concerns many people. The recommended ages by many veterinarians are:

Cats: male and female, before 5 months

Dogs: male - small breeds, before 5 months

male - large breeds, 15 to 18 months

female - before 5 months

The incidence of pyometra and mammary cancer can be greatly reduced by spaying female dogs and cats early. Spayed Female dogs that have experienced heat cycles and/or pregnancies present much more difficult spay surgeries and recoveries.

Please heed the advice of the veterinary professionals and have your cats and dogs 'fixed' early.
