The Rozzie May Animal Alliance newsletter is written with the intent to inform, inspire and connect with you. Things have been busy as usual here! RMAA began 2025 with the annual *Beat the Heat* event.... February is National Spay and Neuter Awareness Month observed to encourage pet owners to spay or neuter their pets. Each year the month of February aims to reduce pet overpopulation and the number of unwanted litters. RMAA takes action every February to counteract pets getting pregnant by offering a clinic special.

World Spay Day is celebrated on the last Tuesday in February. It began in 1995 with Doris Day Animal League as *Spay Day USA*. The movement later spread globally. There is no better way to show your pets love than by having them spayed or neutered while reducing pet overpopulation and improving the health of your pets.

Additionally, in 2025, RMAA identified the need to modernize both our computer systems and our RMAA website. This modernization project will help us provide improved processes for scheduling clients and making payments utilizing Venmo via a QR code. These updates should be completed and in place before May.

Besides spring being RMAA's busiest season performing spay neuter surgeries, RMAA has much work to do behind the scenes and beyond the usual clinic workday. In the months ahead, we require maintenance at the RMAA Clinic, located at 54 Hobbs Street, Conway, NH. This includes having the clinic's metal roof re-painted and our chimney inspected. We plan to have the clinic and garage power washed and the grounds will require tending. You can see that there is a great deal of background work that takes place to keep Rozzie May Animal Alliance doors open and in tip-top shape to serve our valued customers.

RMAA depends on donations from individuals, like you, to help cover the costs required to provide high quality, low cost, spay neuter. Helping RMAA can come through your offer to volunteer, a donation to the "RMAA wish list" or by making a financial donation. It can be a single donation or a monthly donation. 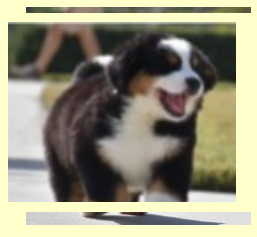
