Greetings RMAA Friends,

In May 2025, RMAA clinical and office support staff, our two RMAA cat cab drivers and several Directors became recertified in Pet CPR and Emergency Care. All participated in a six hour hands-on class. April Begosh, of Healthy Pets NH, specializes in training pet professionals in emergency care. The class was excellent and provided all attendees with a 2-year certification.

We celebrated a major milestone in May 2025 by completing the 35,000th Spay Neuter surgery! RMAA is dedicated to reducing the number of homeless and unwanted pets in New Hampshire and Western Maine. RMAA offers affordable, high quality, spay neuter services at its clinic at 54 Hobbs Street, Conway NH, providing outreach through its “Cat Cab service” business model. We serve family-owned pets, rescues and shelters. Did you know that according to the Spay-Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP), Inc., in seven years, up to 508 puppies can be born from one unspayed female dog and her offspring and up to 4,948 kittens can be born from one unspayed female cat and her offspring. According to a National Council of Pet Population Study, 56% of dogs and 71% of cats that enter shelters are euthanized. If you care about the welfare of dogs and cats, spaying and neutering your pet is the best option.

RMAA depends on donations from individuals, like you, to help cover the costs required to provide high quality, affordable, spay neuter. Helping RMAA can come through your offer to volunteer, a donation to the “RMAA wish list” or by making a financial donation. It can be made through a single or a monthly donation. Donations go directly to the provision of low cost spay neuter surgery. No amount is too small and will make a difference!
